


Installation Instructions

Chief Tachometer Assembly

Congratulations on the purchase of this Chief Tachometer Assembly for your INDIAN Chief. For correct installation and maximum safety, please take the time to read the procedures and carefully follow all instructions.




Materials Required


TACH Assembly


- 1 Remove seat.
- 2 Disconnect the negative battery cable from the battery.
- 3 Remove the dash / console assembly (unplug 2 connectors, to completely remove).
- 4 Remove the Chrome cover from the handlebars.
- 5 Secure the (supplied) triple tree apron in place.
- 6 Remove existing upper handlebar clamp.
- 7 Support the handlebars, to keep from scratching paint or damage from dropping.
- 8 Feed the wires from the tach down through the upper triple tree, (with hand control wires).
- 9 Install your handlebars with the new handlebar clamp and snug the loctited bolts.
- 10 Adjust your handlebars to your preferred position.
- 11 Torque the (4) handlebar clamp bolts in an X pattern to 30 ft-lbs.
- 12 Align the bolt holes in the TACH Assembly housing, with the new upper handlebar mounting clamp, and start the bolts.
- 13 Torque the TACH Assembly housing bolts (supplied) to the new handlebar upper mounting clamp to 15 ft-lbs.
- 14 Feed the wires between the gas tanks.
- 15 Each wire is labeled to show the correct hook up location.
- 15a Connect the pins and sockets as shown in the pictures to the 2 connectors supplied. Insert wedgelocks.

- 15b Disconnect the CAM Trigger 3-pin DEUTSCH connector and connect the wiring harness. (see page 3 for pictures)
- 16 The yellow wire is used only in a single fire application.
- 16a For single fire attach the yellow wire to a ground lug in between the gas tanks..
- 17 Look over wiring to insure there is no possibility to pinch, burn, or stretch your wiring.
- 18 Reconnect the negative battery cable to the battery.
- 19 Start engine to check operation of tach.
- 20 Turn engine off.
- 21 Join the (2) connectors to your dash.
- 22 Reinstall your console.
- 23 Reinstall your seat.
- 24 Insure free lock to lock rotation of your handlebars.
- 25 Test ride bike in a controlled area, to insure proper operation of your motorcycle.
